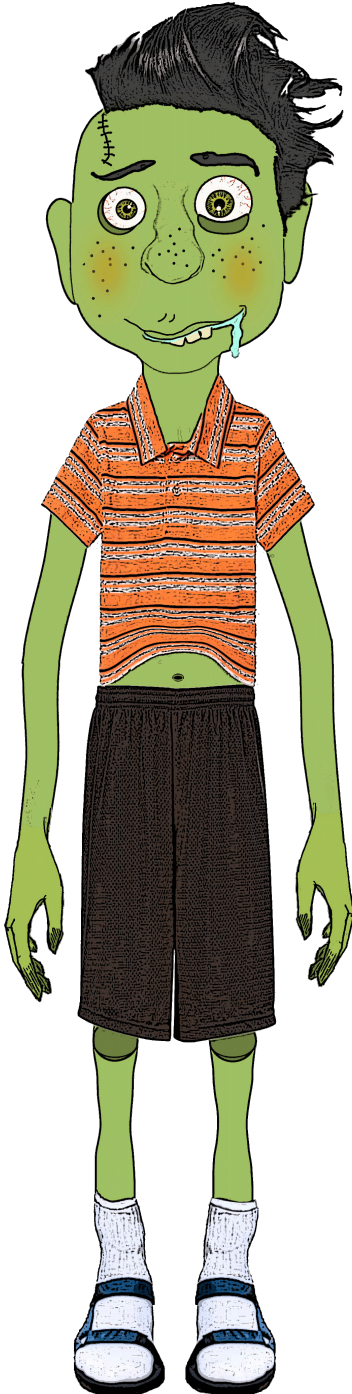

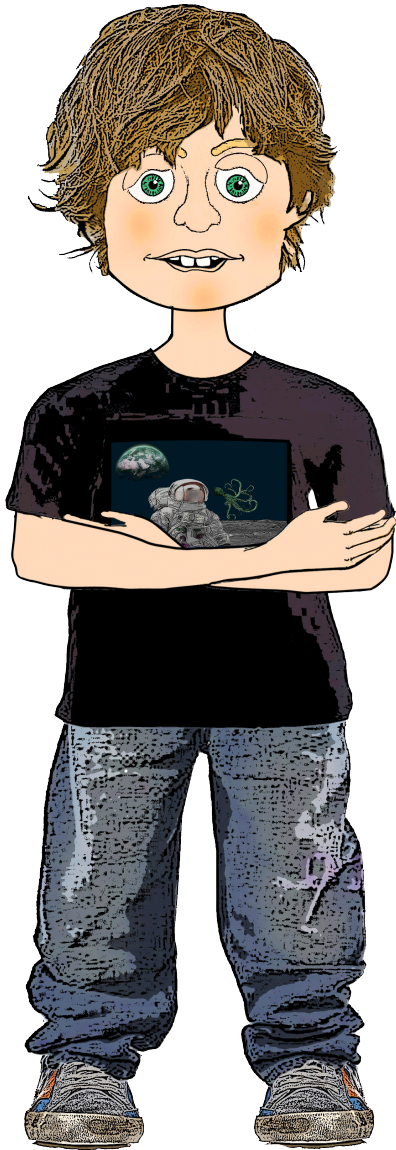


What Kinda Name is Blart?
